Dear 8th Grade Students and Parents:

Can you believe it's time for high school registration!?! High schools are busy preparing forms and information that we need to help students make appropriate course selections for next year. Eighth grade teachers are considering their recommendations for students' course levels for 9th grade, and I am organizing the materials and instructions for you to be able to make informed decisions.

The majority of our students are assigned to attend either Millbrook, Wake Forest-Rolesville or Wakefield High School. All of the high schools are putting transition plans in place so that the move to the larger high school environment will be smooth and successful.

On the back of this sheet is a tentative timeline of registration activities that I will be providing at the middle school. Teachers, parents, students, and I will coordinate efforts in completing the course selection process. After courses have been selected, students will enter their selections online, using either SAM (Student Assistant Module) at school or SPAN (Student/Parent Access Network) at home. All students are required to register for their base high school first. Courses may also be selected for other Wake County public high schools of interest. Magnet application response letters will be sent to parents by mid March, so students who have been accepted at a magnet school can complete online registration for their new assignment.

I look forward to working with you to complete the registration process.
